Dr. Jillian McLeod will be presenting **"I Can't Believe that I Fell for That for So Long': Confronting My Unconscious Subscription to the Ideology of Exclusive Excellence."** Here at CGA we proudly describe ourselves as a community of servants. Yet, some among us are, and have historically been, "under-served" by our institutional practices and policies. In contrast, a visibly homogeneous majority of us are consistently "better-served" by what we do and how we do it, in and outside the classroom. In this presentation, Dr. McLeod seeks to identify the ways in which her own pedagogical practices (unconsciously) perpetuate a culture of inequity and exclusive excellence, and invites others to do the same. She will highlight some of the relevant scholarship from Critical Race Theory and Mathematics Education that supports this kind of inquiry as well as offer suggestions for individual and institutional reform toward equity-minded, evidence-based pedagogical practices intended to upset the status quo of exclusive excellence.
